

2 What is GMAL?

- 2.1 The Greater Manchester Accessibility Levels (GMAL) dataset represents the accessibility from locations to the public transport network, taking into account walk access time and service availability.
- 2.2 There are two data files – one containing GMAL values for the centroids of a 100 metre square grid system covering Greater Manchester (the ‘grid’ version), and one with values for the centroid of each postcode in Greater Manchester (the ‘postcode’ version).

6 Known issues and limitations

- 6.1 Some parts of the dataset may be less up-to-date than the rest, for example rail data. See the Data updates section below for more information.
- 6.2 The PTALTheme field is not available in the ‘grid’ version.
- 6.3 Some past editions of the dataset included those school bus services which are available for the general public to use. The GMAL calculation included these from February 2022 to July 2023 inclusive (NB: school services do not run during the holidays, i.e. August 2022, and April 2023). Consequently, there is a slight difference if comparing historic data from before and after these changes.
- 6.4 Transport for Greater Manchester would be interested to hear of any other issues that you come across.

7 Data updates

- 7.1 At the time of writing, Transport for Greater Manchester aims to update this dataset at least quarterly, if not monthly.
- 7.2 GMAL is calculated using data about the public transport network that existed on specific date(s). These date(s) may differ from one transport mode to another, and can be found in the “Version.txt” file accompanying the data.
